My dwelling place shall be.

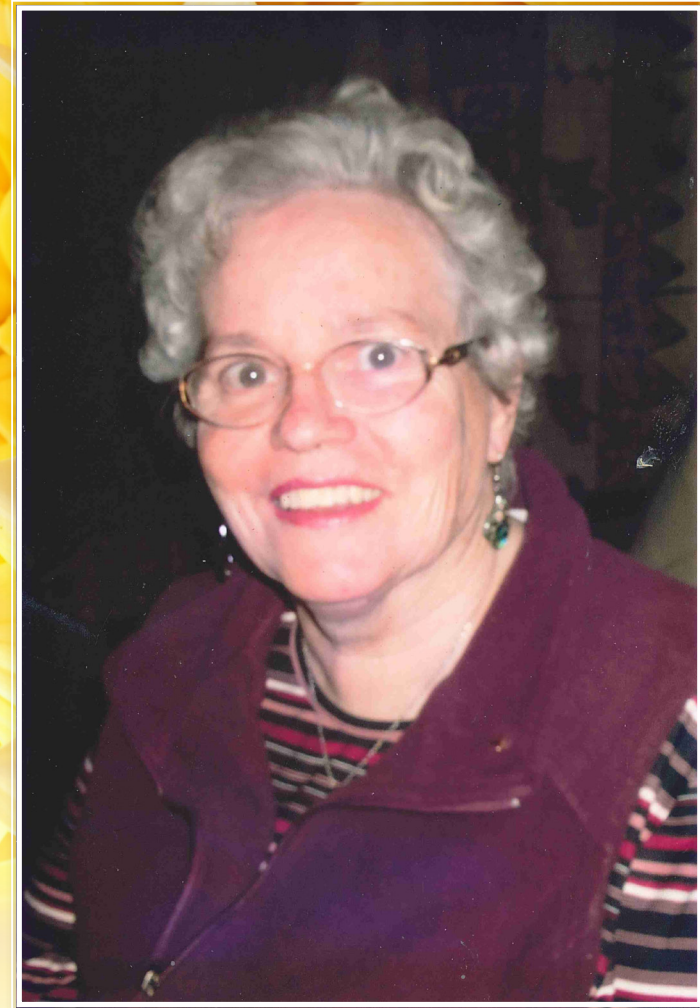
